

## You are invited to attend the Grants Chlorinated Solvent Plume Superfund Site Virtual Public Meeting February 7, 2023



The United States Environmental Protection Agency Region 6 (EPA), in coordination with the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), will be hosting a virtual community meeting to provide a status update on the cleanup of the Grants Chlorinated Solvent Plume Superfund Site (GCSP Site), located in Grants, Cibola County, New Mexico.

The GCSP Site consists of soil and groundwater contamination containing the chlorinated solvents tetrachloroethylene (PCE) and trichloroethene (TCE). The presence of these solvents is a result of past releases from dry cleaning operations. The cleanup has included the use of technologies to apply heat to destroy the contaminants in soil and introduce micro-organisms to consume and breakdown the contaminants in groundwater. In addition, indoor air treatment systems have been installed in several residential buildings to reduce the levels of solvent vapors that moved upward from groundwater and intruded into buildings.

The virtual community meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, February 7, 2023, from 7:00-9:00 PM Mountain Time.
