**RE: NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND RESOLUTION
GREENWOOD MOTORLINES DBA R & L CARRIERS

Dear Mr. Roberts

On February 27, 2023, the New Mexico Environment Department ("NMED") conducted a hazardous waste Compliance Evaluation Inspection ("Inspection") at Greenwood Motorlines DBA R&L Carriers ("R&L") located at 2350 Aztec Road NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico. R&L is a freight shipping and logistics company.

Based on observations and review of the information obtained, NMED has determined that R&L is a Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste as defined in 40 Code of Federal Regulations ("CFR") 262.13. Furthermore, NMED has determined that R&L has violated the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations ("HWMR") 20.4.3 New Mexico Administrative Code ("NMAC") as specified below.

NMED Inspectors observed the following violation:

1. Failure to pay Hazardous Waste Generator fees, which is a violation of 20.4.3.201(B) NMAC. Specifically, generator fees for calendar years 2020 and 2021 have not been paid. Generator fees are due by the 1st of August of the following year. Fees for 2020 were due by August 1, 2021, and 2021 fees were due by August 1, 2022.

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NMED has determined that the violations have been adequately addressed from the remittance of payment received on April 10, 2023 for past due hazardous waste generator fees; therefore, no further action is required.

This Notice of Violation is considered an informal enforcement response in accordance with NMED's Enforcement Response Protocol. Please be aware that failure to address the above violations and any future substantial deviations from regulatory requirements may result in R&L being considered for an elevated enforcement action. Also, be aware that any corrective action taken during our Inspection, or in response to this letter, does not relieve R&L of its obligation to comply with any and all other applicable laws and regulations.

Pursuant to the NMED Delegation Order dated March 24, 2023, the Cabinet Secretary has delegated the authority to issue Notices of Violation under the Hazardous Waste Act and HWMRs to the Chief of the Hazardous Waste Bureau.
