## **Re:** Groundwater Discharge Permits Proposed for Approval

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Ground Water Quality Bureau (GWQB) hereby provides notice pursuant to 20.6.2.3108.H NMAC that the following Groundwater Discharge Permits have been proposed for approval. Prior to ruling, NMED will allow thirty days after the date of publication of this notice during which time written comments may be submitted and a public hearing may be requested. Requests for public hearing shall be in writing and shall set forth the reasons why a hearing should be held. A hearing will be held if NMED determines that there is substantial public interest.

NMED encourages the public to learn about and be involved in regulatory decision-making opportunities. For each proposed permitted activity, NMED maintains a Public Involvement Plan (PIP) to identify all communities potentially affected by the proposed permitting activity and expand public participation opportunities to accommodate the needs of those communities. Additionally, NMED maintains a facility specific mailing list for persons who wish to receive future notices.

To request additional information, to be placed on a facility specific mailing list, to obtain a copy of a draft permit or associated PIP, or to submit a comment or a request for hearing, contact the GWQB at PO Box 5469, Santa Fe, NM 87502-5469, (505) 827-2900.
