RE: Notice of Violation – Failure to provide Public Notice

Dear Mayor Glenda Greene,

Our records indicate that the Lordsburg Water Supply System (WSS) did not provide public notice to customers and/or did not return a Public Notice Certification Form to the New Mexico Environment Department-Drinking Water Bureau (NMED-DWB) for the Fluoride Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) Notice of Violation (NOV) issued on February 14, 2024.

Pursuant to Section 20.7.10.100 NMAC [incorporating 40 CFR Section 141.204], the Lordsburg WSS was required to notify customers of the violation by **mail or other direct delivery to each customer** and any other methods as necessary to inform the public, within 30 days from the date on the original NOV.

Pursuant to 20.7.10.100 NMAC [incorporating 40 CFR Section 141.31(d)], the Lordsburg WSS was required to certify, within 10 days, that the public notice was published and specify the method of publication by submitting a completed copy of the Public Notification Certification Form.

The Lordsburg WSS is still required to provide public notice for the NOV issued on February 14, 2024. Please complete the public notice requirements and return the Public Notice Certification Form to Aaron Beckworth by email at: aaron.beckworth@env.nm.gov

NMED-DWB reserves the right to take additional enforcement action regarding the violations identified in this NOV, to include the issuance of an Administrative Compliance Order compelling compliance and issuing civil penalties.

Pursuant to the NMED Delegation Order dated February 19, 2024, the Cabinet Secretary has delegated the authority to issue Notice of Violations to DWB Compliance Supervisor Brandi Littleton.

Please note that your public water system will appear on the Department's Enforcement Watch as a result of this NOV (see: <https://www.env.nm.gov/enforcement-watch/>). Further, the Department will issue a press release to local media highlighting your public water system as appearing on this webpage. Your public water system will remain on the Enforcement Watch website until this matter is fully resolved.
