### RE: Notice of Violation – Failure to Provide Public Notice

Dear Maria Gilvarry:

Our records indicate that the City of Las Vegas water system did not provide public notice to your customers within the required timeframes for the November 2023 Max NTU Notice of Violation (NOV) issued on November 21, 2023. Public notice was due to your customers before November 22, 2023. The City of Las Vegas provided public notice to customers late on December 1, 2023.

Pursuant to Section 20.7.10.100 NMAC [incorporating 40 CFR Section 141.202(a)(5)], you were required to notify your customers of the violation by **mail or other direct delivery to each customer** and any other methods as necessary to inform the public, within 24 hours from the date on the original NOV.

Because the public notice provided to customers was late, the City of Las Vegas water system was in violation. The City of Las Vegas water system is not required to take further action concerning the late public notice.

Please note that your facility will appear on the Department's Enforcement Watch as a result of this NOV (see: <https://www.env.nm.gov/enforcement-watch/>). Further, the Department will issue a press release to local media highlighting your public water system as appearing on this webpage. Your public water system will remain on the Enforcement Watch website as an active matter until this matter is fully resolved.

Pursuant to the NMED Delegation Order dated February 19, 2024, the Cabinet Secretary has delegated the authority to issue Notice of Violations to DWB Supervisor Brandi Littleton.
